



Sample Bequest Language

You can include Conservation Corps North Bay in your will in several ways:

1. The most common method is to include a **bequest** for:
 - a percentage of your estate,
 - a specific dollar amount, or
 - the residue of your estate after providing for others

One beautiful way to think of all of the people you'd like to help is to think of them as one of your children, and distribute your estate among your children and loved ones or charities.

2. You may also name Conservation Corps North Bay as a **contingent beneficiary** in the event that other beneficiaries predecease you.
3. Another thoughtful arrangement is to establish a **trust in your will** that provides lifetime income for a loved one with the remainder eventually going to Conservation Corps North Bay.

For the purposes of including Conservation Corps North Bay in your will, our legal name is **“Conservation Corps North Bay, Inc.”**, a **California nonprofit public benefit corporation**. Conservation Corps North Bay is a 501(3)c organization, tax identification number 94-2831592.

By including Conservation Corps North Bay in your will you are helping CCNB develop youth and conserve natural resources for a strong, sustainable community.

Sample Bequest Provisions

Everyone's will is a very personal document. Its provisions depend on their wishes and circumstances. Perhaps one of these provisions will be helpful for you:

Gift of a Percent of One's Estate

I give to Conservation Corps North Bay, Inc., a California nonprofit public benefit corporation, tax identification number 94-2831592, with headquarters currently located at 27 Larkspur Street, San Rafael, California, 94901, ____ % of my estate for its general purposes.

Specific Legacy

I bequeath _____ (name a specific asset, such as a home, farm, livestock, stocks, mutual funds, etc.) to Conservation Corps North Bay, Inc., a California nonprofit public benefit corporation, tax identification number 94-2831592, with headquarters currently located at 27 Larkspur Street, San Rafael, California, 94901, for its general purposes.

Gift for a Specific Purpose

I give to Conservation Corps North Bay, Inc., a California nonprofit public benefit corporation, tax identification number 94-2831592, with headquarters currently located at 27 Larkspur Street, San Rafael, California, 94901, the sum of \$ _____ (or _____% of my estate; or the property herein described) to be used for _____ (specify the purpose).

Gift of Remainder after Other Bequests Have Been Made

All the rest, residue, and remainder of my estate, both real and personal, I give to Conservation Corps North Bay, Inc., a California nonprofit public benefit corporation, tax identification number 94-2831592, with headquarters currently located at 27 Larkspur Street, San Rafael, California, 94901.

Contingency Gift

I give to the residue of the property owned by me at my death, real and personal, to my wife, (husband) _____, if she, (he) survives me. If my wife (husband) does not survive me, I give my residuary estate to Conservation Corps North Bay, Inc., a California nonprofit public benefit corporation, tax identification number 94-2831592, with headquarters currently located at 27 Larkspur Street, San Rafael, California, 94901.

Final Contingency Beneficiary

I give the residue of the property owned by me at my death, real and personal to my above-named beneficiaries, if they survive me. If my above-named beneficiaries do not survive me, I give my residuary estate to Conservation Corps North Bay, Inc., a California nonprofit public benefit corporation, tax identification number 94-2831592, with headquarters currently located at 27 Larkspur Street, San Rafael, California, 94901.

A Double-Purpose Bequest

You can provide a relative or friend with income for life through a special gift to Conservation Corps North Bay. You can do this by establishing a charitable trust through your Will. Upon your death, the trust pays income to the person you designate. After that person's death, whatever remains in the trust passes to Conservation Corps North Bay.
